Summer:

- Red Godstowe jumper
- Red polo shirts
- Godstowe cycling shorts (girls)
- Red P.E. shorts (boys)

They will also need:

- · Red lunch overall
- · Red painting apron
- · Red drawstring P.E. bag
- · Godstowe book bag
- · Red sun hat
- Godstowe Sheet for nap time (purchased from Godstowe Uniform Shop only)
- *Woolly hat
- *Gloves
- *A coat
- *Shoes should be closed in and simple for your child to take off and put on
- * these items do not need to be school uniform

Uniform items may be bought directly from the Godstowe Uniform Shop which is located within the grounds. You may make an initial fitting appointment by emailing uniformshop@godstowe.org. The shop can be found in the second cottage across the Lodge playground, and the openings times are listed on the back of this booklet.

Your child will also need:

- A change of clothes and underwear to be left on their peg in a bag (this is for emergency use and does not have to be uniform)
- Wellington boots
